**“A WORD FROM PASTOR DAN”** The Apostle Paul began his letter to the believers in Rome by saying in verse 8, “First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all!” I would like to begin my newsletter comments the same way. I thank God for all of you here at the Fellowship @ Field Store. Avonell and I have now been here for about 4 months serving as your interim pastor. I thank God for the kindness you have shown us and how you have welcomed us into your midst. I apologize that I continue to struggle with everyone’s names, but I am making slow progress in that area.

I am thankful for the Spirit of Unity that I feel and observe in our congregation. When we read the beautiful prayer of Jesus to His Father in John, Chapter 17, Jesus prayed this way in verse 21; “that they all may be one, as you, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.” Jesus says in that verse that the world will become believers when they see the unity in the church is like the unity between the Father and Son. We must protect and increase the unity within our church if we ever want to reach our lost loved ones, neighbors, students, etc.

I am thankful for God’s Spirit and His Presence as He meets with us when we gather to worship. Sunday was a great day as we had Trey come for baptism and share his testimony. Then we had the great fellowship meal and the gospel singing. Thanks Cathy for playing the piano and leading us in the gospel singing. The ladies that gathered around the piano made a great ladies choir! Again, it was a blessed day!

I have already heard many good things from our students and chaperones that went to youth camp. I look forward to hearing from then in our worship service this Sunday.

We are in the process of asking members to continue or fill positions in the church for the coming year. When we have our member’s meeting on Sunday afternoon, August 26, we will be voting to confirm members and positions. Please consider where God would have you serve in the coming year and let us know your willingness to be used.

## JOYFUL NOISE

As we walk through the end of July and head toward August and September, it is somewhat sobering to think about another 8 to 10 weeks of oppressive heat and humidity that we will be facing. Even with the heat, we have seen a flurry of activity already this summer. The Appalachian mission trip is in the books, VBS has come and gone, teens are heading to camp and then the pre-teens will head out. In our family, we have had about half of the summer birthday and anniversary celebrations. We have had four VBS events in our small family group involving our kids and grandkids and my wife. Our two daughters and our daughter-in-law all played key leadership roles in planning and executing VBS at their respective churches. We have had two baseball camps and one musical theater camp happen. There was tournament baseball and now we are getting into recreational summertime activities. One group has already gone to Florida, one group is headed to Florida – Disney World – and one group is making a summer out of visiting Texas beaches. I caught a video yesterday of three of my grands in the garage doing a very colorful science experiment that somehow ended up all over the floor and the walls.

Summertime is busy. If we don't make it a point to take a look at where we are, we will likely find ourselves in some unfamiliar place that we never intended to visit. Paul starts his second letter to Timothy with a great greeting – my dearly loved son - grace, mercy and peace to you Timothy from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. I suspect that even back in the day, times could get crazy. Paul starts this very important letter with a reminder to Timothy of his identity in relation to the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

Paul was busy serving God – and serving with a clear conscience. The proof of his pure motive was in his constant prayer for Timothy – remembering him night and day. As Paul remembered Timothy, he remembered Timothy's emotion – his tears – it made Paul want to see Timothy even more – not just for Timothy's sake, but also so that Paul would be filled with joy by simply seeing Timothy. Timothy's sincere faith – patterned after the faith he saw in his grandmother Lois and then in his mother Eunice was the same kind of faith that Paul could see in Timothy. Paul urged Timothy to keep the fire burning – the fire from the gift that God had placed in Timothy. Paul urged Timothy to stoke the fire of his powerful gift of love and sound judgment.

I like being busy, but it is so much better when our activity is filled with purpose. I hope you will hear God's call to fire up your spiritual gift-remember that you can be bold – unafraid – fearless as you put your gift to work. Use it in power and use it in love and use good judgment when you are using it. I guess this brings a question forward, as to how we can use our spiritual gifts if we are not sure what they are. There are studies that will help us find out about our giftedness if you are not sure about yours. When you find out – you probably won't be surprised – if the Holy Spirit is in you, He is already encouraging you to use your gifts – not only that, God's design for gifts is such that we tend to love the thing that we are called to do.

Let's endure the heat and fire up our gifts as we worship together and encourage one another. Take some time to remember who you are in relationship with God and with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Give God thanks for your gifts and ask Him to help you exercise your gifts with enthusiasm, with power and with love. If your gifts include encouragement or teaching, you might find a great place to serve in leading worship alongside others. A Christian song writer named Steve Green wrote these words –

“O may all who come behind us find us faithful  
May the fire of our devotion light their way  
May the footprints that we leave lead them to believe  
And the lives we live inspire them to obey  
O may all who come behind us find us faithful.


