**HERE ARE SOME RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE DAY:**

**AS WE ARE FASTING I WOULD ENCOURAGE YOU TO STAY HYDRATED BY DRINKING WATER THROUGHOUT THE DAY. SOME BECAUSE OF MEDICATION OR MEDICAL ISSUES MAY NEED TO EAT A LITTLE SOMETHING OR DRINK JUICE, ETC. WHICH IS FINE.**

**OUR PURPOSE TODAY IS TO FAST AND PRAY, HOWEVER, YOU ARE NOT EXPECTED TO PRAY FOR 12 HOURS CONTINUOUSLY. SOMEONE HAS SAID, WHEN WE PRAY WE TALK TO GOD AND WHEN WE READ HIS WORD, HE TALKS TO US. YOU ARE SPENDING THE DAY WITH OUR LORD, BE SURE NOT TO DO ALL THE TALKING. TAKE TIME TO LISTEN TO WHAT HE WANTS TO TELL YOU. HE IS THRILLED THAT YOU HAVE COMMITTED TO SPEND THE DAY WITH HIM AND JUST AS YOU HAVE MUCH TO SAY AND ASK OF HIM, HE HAS MUCH TO SAY AND ASK OF YOU.**

**SLOW DOWN, TAKE YOU TIME AND REST IN HIM TODAY. TAKE A WALK WITH OUR LORD OUTSIDE (WEATHER PERMITTING) AND LET HIM SPEAK TO YOU, STILL YOUR HEART AND CLEAR YOUR MIND.**

**LISTEN TO SOME WORSHIP MUSIC AND ENJOY HIS PRESENCE. ASK HIM TO REVEAL HIMSELF TO YOU IN A GREATER WAY THAN EVER BEFORE.**

**PRAY FOR THESE FOR OUR CHURCH**

**FIRST, JESUS PRAYED THAT HIS PEOPLE WOULD EXPERIENCE THE GLORY (PRESENCE) OF GOD (JOHN 17:22)**

**SECOND, JESUS PRAYED THAT WE WOULD FOLLOW THE WORD OF GOD (JOHN 17:8)**

**THIRD, JESUS PRAYED THAT HIS CHURCH WOULD BE UNITED IN THE LOVE OF GOD (JOHN 17:11, 21, 22, 23)**

**FOURTH, JESUS PRAYED THAT WE WOULD GO FORTH IN THE MISSION OF GOD (JOHN 17:17-18)**

**FIFTH, JESUS PRAYED THAT WE WOULD EXPERIENCE THE JOY OF GOD (JOHN 17:13)**

**SPECIFIC NEEDS OF OUR CHURCH**

**FIRST, PRAY THAT GOD WOULD PROVIDE A PASTOR**

**THE BIBLE SAYS IF WE ASK ANYTHING ACCORDING TO GOD'S WILL HE HEARS US. WE KNOW IT IS HIS WILL THAT OUR CHURCH HAVE PASTOR/SHEPHERD.**

**HERE IS HIS PROMISE FOR A PASTOR/SHEPHERD:**

**JEREMIAH 3:15 “AND I WILL GIVE YOU PASTORS ACCORDING TO MY HEART, WHO WILL FEED YOU WITH KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING”.**

**JEREMIAH 23:4 “AND I WILL SET UP SHEPHERDS OVER THEM WHO WILL FEED THEM: AND THEY SHALL FEAR NO MORE, NOR BE DISMAYED, NOR SHALL THEY BE LACKING, SAYS THE LORD.”**

**WHEN YOU PRAY FOR YOUR NEW PASTOR YOU ARE PRAYING IN ACCORDANCE TO HIS WILL AND ARE CLAIMING HIS PROMISE.**

**SECOND, PRAY FOR THE CHURCH’S FINANCIAL NEEDS TO SUPPORT A PASTOR.**

**THROUGH MAN’S EYES I BELIEVE THIS TO BE OUR CHURCH’S LARGEST CHALLENGE TODAY. THE INCOME TO THE CHURCH (TITHES/OFFERINGS) MUST INCREASE IN ORDER FOR THE CHURCH TO COMPENSATE A PASTOR AND HIS FAMILY.**

**WE MUST PRAY AND ACT IN ACCORDANCE TO MALACHI 3:10 WHERE THE LORD MAKES THIS PROMISE:**

**“BRING ALL THE TITHES INTO THE STOREHOUSE, THAT THERE MAY BE FOOD IN MY HOUSE, AND TRY ME NOW IN THIS, SAYS THE LORD OF HOSTS. IF I WILL NOT OPEN FOR YOU THE WINDOWS OF HEAVEN AND POUR OUT FOR YOU SUCH BLESSING THAT THERE WILL NOT BE ROOM ENOUGH TO RECEIVE IT.”**



**THIS IS WHAT IS CALLED IN SCRIPTURE A CONDITIONAL PROMISE. THE CHURCH MUST MEET A CONDITION BEFORE GOD WILL SEND THE BLESSING.**

**THE CONDITION IS “BRING ALL THE TITHES”. AS MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH TITHE GOD THEN SAYS HE WILL NOT BE OUTGIVEN. IF WE GIVE OUR PART, HE SAYS HE WILL OPEN THE WINDOWS OF HEAVEN AND POUR OUT A BLESSING ON HIS CHURCH.**

**WE MUST PRAY FIRST, THAT OUR MEMBERS WOULD HONOR GOD WITH THEIR TITHES AND THEN ASK GOD TO FULFILL HIS PROMISE BY POURING OUT HIS BLESSING ON THE CHURCH TO MEET THE FINANCIAL NEEDS OF A NEW PASTOR AND ALL OF OUR EXISTING MINISTRIES.**

**IN ADDITION, PLEASE PRAY THE FOLLOWING VERSE:**

**PHILLIPIANS 4:19 “AND MY GOD SHALL SUPPLY ALL YOUR NEED ACCORDING TO HIS RICHES IN GLORY BY CHRIST JESUS.”**

**THIRD, PRAY THAT GOD WOULD ADD MEMBERS TO THE CHURCH**

**JESUS TOLD HIS DISCIPLES IN MATTHEW 16:18:**

**“AND I ALSO SAY TO YOU THAT YOU ARE PETER, AND ON THIS ROCK I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH, AND THE GATES OF HADES SHALL NOT PREVAIL AGAINST IT.”**

**PRAYING THAT GOD WILL BUILD OUR CHURCH IS IN COMPLETE AGREEMENT WITH SCRIPTURE AND**

**GOD’S WILL. ANOTHER VERSE WE CAN PRAY BACK TO GOD THAT SUPPORTS HIM SENDING US ADDITIONAL MEMBERS/WORKERS IS MATTHEW 9:37 – 38:**

**“THEN HE SAID TO HIS DISCIPLES, THE HARVEST TRULY IS PLENTIFUL, BUT THE LABORERS ARE FEW. THEREFORE, PRAY THE LORD OF THE HARVEST TO SEND OUT LABORERS INTO HIS HARVEST.”**

**AS WE PRAY FOR GOD TO BUILD THE CHURCH, WE CAN THANK HIM THAT HE HAS TOLD US IN HIS WORD THAT HE WILL SUPPLY ALL OUR NEEDS, HE WILL BUILD THE CHURCH AND HE WILL SEND FORTH THE NEEDED LABORERS.**

**FOURTH, PRAY THAT GOD WOULD BUILD HIS CHURCH NOT ONLY BY SENDING WORKERS BUT THAT LOST PEOPLE WE KNOW AND LOVE WOULD BE SAVED AND BECOME A PART OF THE FELLOWSHIP.**

**THE BIBLE SAYS THAT “GOD IS NOT WILLING THAT ANY SHOULD PERISH BUT THAT ALL WOULD COME TO REPENTANCE.”**

**AS YOU ARE PRAYING FOR LOST PEOPLE TO BE SAVED TRY MAKING A LIST OF PEOPLE YOU KNOW WHO ARE NOT SAVED, THEN PRAY THE FOLLOWING FOR THEM:**

**THAT GOD WILL CONVICT THEM AND DRAW THEM BY HIS SPIRIT. (JOHN 6:44, JOHN 14:6, JOHN 16:8 – 11)**

**THAT GOD WILL OPEN THEIR MIND TO THE TRUTH. (MATTHEW 13:15, ACTS 26:17 – 18)**

**THAT THEY WILL BE RELEASED FROM STRONGHOLDS THAT PREVENT PLACING THEIR FAITH IN GOD (II TIMOTHY 2:25 – 26, COLOSSIANS 1:13)**

**THAT THE LORD WILL SEND SOMEONE TO SHARE THE GOSPEL WITH THEM. (ROMANS 10:14 – 15)**

**FINALLY, DON'T STOP PRAYING FOR THEM. PRAY WITHOUT CEASING! I THESSALONIANS 5:17**

**FIFTH, PRAY FOR ALL THE MEMBERS OF OUR CHURCH THE FOLLOWING:**

**INTERCESSORY PRAYER FOR INDIVIDUALS**

**JOB 16: 20 – 21 “MY INTERCESSOR IS MY FRIEND AS MY EYES POUR OUT TEARS TO GOD; ON BEHALF OF A MAN HE PLEADS WITH GOD AS A MAN PLEADS FOR HIS FRIEND.”**

- **PRAY THAT THEY KNOW GOD’S WILL FOR THEIR LIVES (COLOSSIANS 1:9 – WE HAVE NOT STOPPED PRAYING FOR YOU AND ASKING GOD TO FILL YOU WITH THE KNOWLEDGE OF HIS WILL THROUGH ALL SPIRITUAL WISDOM AND UNDERSTANDING.)**
- **PRAY THAT THEY WOULD DO GOD’S WILL IN THEIR LIVES (COLOSSIANS 1:10 – WE PRAY THIS IN ORDER THAT YOU MAY LIVE A LIFE WORTHY OF THE LORD AND MAY PLEASE HIM IN EVERY WAY: BEARING FRUIT IN EVERY GOOD WORK.)**

- **PRAY FOR PRODUCTIVITY IN THEIR LIVES**  
(JOHN 15:16 I CHOSE YOU AND APPOINTED YOU TO GO AND BEAR FRUIT – FRUIT THAT WILL LAST.)
- **PRAY FOR THEM TO HAVE A GROWING RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD** (COLOSSIANS 1:10 – INCREASING IN THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD)
- **PRAY FOR GOD’S POWER IN THEIR LIVES**  
(COLOSSIANS 1:11 – STRENGTHENED WITH ALL MIGHT, ACCORDING TO HIS GLORIOUS POWER, FOR ALL PATIENCE AND LONGSUFFERING WITH JOY.)
- **PRAY FOR THEM TO HAVE A RIGHT ATTITUDE** (COLOSSIANS 1:12 – GIVING THANKS UNTO THE FATHER, WHO HAS QUALIFIED US TO BE PARTAKERS OF THE INHERITANCE OF THE SAINTS IN LIGHT)

**SIXTH, PRAY FOR THE STUDENT AND CHILDREN’S MINISTRIES OF THE CHURCH**

**GOD HAS BLESSED OUR CHURCH WITH A STRONG CHILDREN’S AND STUDENT MINISTRY. THE NUMBER OF YOUNG PEOPLE ATTENDING ON SUNDAYS AND WEDNESDAY NIGHTS MAKE UP A HIGH PERCENTAGE OF THE TOTAL PEOPLE ATTENDING. ALONG WITH THIS BLESSING COMES MUCH ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE CHURCH. WE ARE ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR SAFETY WHILE IN OUR CARE (INCLUDING IN THE VAN). WE ARE ACCOUNTABLE TO GOD TO INTRODUCE THEM TO JESUS AND SALVATION FOUND**

## **ONLY IN HIM AND THEN ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR SPIRITUAL GROWTH.**
