**“A WORD FROM PASTOR DAN”** Please note that this will be our last monthly newsletter. The newsletter will be published quarterly rather than monthly going forward. I have been reading a 40-day devotional called The Easter Code. It was authored by O.S. Hawkins and the focus of the devotionals is to focus attention on Jesus' life and ministry as He traveled toward His trial, conviction, crucifixion and resurrection. Dr. Hawkins has some wonderful things to say and it would be worth your time to get a copy of this little devotional booklet. By the time you read this, Easter will have come and gone along with Mother's Day and Memorial Day. But, for us, there is never a day when Easter is not relevant. Every day is a great day to remember Jesus' purpose driven life and the culmination of all creation when God Himself, in the form of His

Only Begotten Son willingly took upon Himself the punishment for our sin so that we could stand clean and forgiven before the Father – having been declared not guilty by the substitutionary work of Jesus' sacrificial gift on the cross at Calvary.

One of the questions that we have to ask about ourselves is what people see when they look at us. Whose branding is apparent in our life? I see lots of people who display the logos of those things that mean a lot to them. With two daughters who graduated from Texas A&M University, I see a lot of people with Aggie branding all over their stuff. As a result of identification with a favorite sports team, you might notice a lot of Houston Astros gear, Houston Texans gear, Houston Dynamo or Houston Rockets gear. You might see people wearing a Chicago Cubs cap or a Yankees cap. Maybe golf is your thing and you have a shirt with your favorite golf insignia. Maybe your branding includes gear that identifies you with a lifestyle – like a cowboy hat, boots, starched jeans, a pearl snap and a big belt buckle. Lots of fashion branding can be seen on a huge array of clothing items and accessories. Maybe you carry a key fob with the brand logo of your automobile manufacturer. Regardless of what it might be, you get the point that we have a tendency to display those things that are important to us. Jesus definitely wears the marks of the thing that defined His life – you can see it in His hands and His feet and on His side. The crowd saw a bloodied, beaten – almost unrecognizable image, but The Father saw something completely different. He saw every one of us. In the person of Jesus Christ, our Heavenly Father saw each one of us who would exchange our sinful lives for a new life that is only available through faith in our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Your life in Christ is not just a changed life – it is an exchanged life. Paul shares his testimony with us in Galatians 2:20 when he says, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

The logo that we bear should be our identification with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Let them see Him in your actions and in your attitude. Let them hear Him when you speak. Look at others through His eyes so that we can see how You love, and let us live for Your glory today, and every day. Let Paul's testimony become your testimony – For I am crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ. That little modifier "But Christ" makes all the difference in this world and in the one to come.

**SUNDAY SCHOOL** A time to remember why Easter Sunday is so important each year. It is the month that our Lord Jesus Christ resurrected for all of us. Let's not just remember this month or day only but let's remember our Lord every day. Jesus suffered and died for us and took our sins upon him to cleanse us of all our sins unconditionally and faithfully.

Just remember every day the sacrifice that was made for each one of us. As our Pastors and Sunday School teachers prepare for this exciting day let us pray for each one of them for taking the time to reach out to the flock to tell the story of our Savior who gave it all for us.

So, let's take this opportunity to reflect what this day means to each one of us. Remember that our Lord and Savior Jesus Loved us for such a time as this. Blessings to all my brothers and sisters in Christ.




